

- The crews will be on location from 8:00 am - 7:00 pm Monday - Friday. Saturdays may be utilized as necessary, and we will communicate that information as it becomes apparent.
- When your building is being worked on, the power will be shut off temporarily for that day during this process to allow the electrical meters to be removed and re-mounted. It will be shut off each morning as early as 8:00 a.m. and turned back on the same day (late afternoon).
- Due to vibrations during the construction, please remove all items from the interior and exterior walls when your building is being resided as a precaution and possible damage to your personal items. For those of you that have built in mirrors on your wall, please protect it, taping may help.
- As your building is being re-sided, all homeowners need to remove their cars from their driveways to prevent damage from debris. If storing a vehicle in the garages during those hours, make sure to move the vehicle before work begins, if you will be using it during the day.
- Most of the materials will be staged in a central location and trash container placement will be in the area that they will be working on at the end cap of the drive, but will not be blocking the main roadways or access to the buildings by fire, ambulance, or police.
- Trash containers at each building for use of the siding company only. Please use care pulling in and out of driveways; clearance of vehicles backing from garages has been verified.
- There will be daily clean-up by crews at the end of the work day. ARI will be responsible for keeping debris picked up. If a flat tire occurs due to a nail puncture, please make sure to keep the nail in order to determine if the cause is from the siding project.
- There will be a lot of noise during the process and unfamiliar people on sight during working hours not only to the building being re-sided but also neighboring buildings, so pets may need to be temporarily off-site during those hours.
- It is recommended to remove all items from the outside areas such as doors, patios, balconies, etc. that could be damaged from debris. Consider storing patio furniture or protecting them with covers away from debris.
- As buildings are being re-sided, wood rot could be a possibility whereas we will need to arrange access to the particular unit within a 24-48 hours' notice. This will be on a case by case basis and cannot be determined prior to the removal of the siding. The entire process will be monitored and inspection from the JamesHardie Company will ensure our siding warranty is upheld.
